

SUMMARY NOTES OF THE GOSPEL

1. The price of sin is not paid by what man did to Jesus, but by what God did to Jesus during the three hours of darkness. (Isaiah 53:4)
2. His soul was made an offering for sin. (Isaiah 53:10)
3. He tasted death for every man. (Hebrews 2:9)
4. Salvation is all of God, by God. (Jonah 2:9)
5. God does it, God gives Himself, the sacrifice for sin. (Genesis 22:8)
6. Jesus was not killed, Jesus gave His life. (John 10:17,18)
7. The work of Salvation was done at the cross:
 - a. Sin put on Him (II Cor. 5:21; I Peter 2:24)
 - b. God judged Him for our sins (Isaiah 53)
 - c. He took our place
 - d. He was our substitute
 - e. We were reconciled to God by His death. (II Cor. 5:18-20; Eph. 2:16,17; Col. 1:20,21; Heb. 2:17)
8. He dies there on that old rugged cross. (Luke 23:46)
9. He is buried in a borrowed tomb, where never was man laid.
10. This burial is nothing but His body. (John 20:12)
11. His spirit ^{gods back to God Eccl 12:7. Matt 27:50} soul goes to the bosom of Abraham, in the heart of the earth. (Ephesians 4:8-10) *Matt 12:38-40*
12. He proclaims He has paid the sin debt to those in waiting for that sin debt to be paid. (I Peter 3:18,19) *Eternal judgment to the Lost*
13. He comes back into His body, and it is a new, resurrected, glorified body, and comes out of those grave clothes and the tomb.
14. This is that first Easter Sunday.
15. He rises as the High Priest, and has a job of taking the blood of the sacrifice to the mercy seat of the tabernacle in heaven. (John 20:16-17; Hebrews 5:5-10; Hebrews 9:11-15; Hebrews 9:23-26)

16. That tabernacle must be cleansed because Lucifer, when he sinned in heaven, defiled it and this is the first time there has been blood good enough to purify the heavenly things. (Hebrews 9:23)
17. Jesus takes His own blood to heaven to purge the sin there, as well as the sin of the whole world.
18. Jesus' blood was offered in heaven, in the presence of God, once for all time and for all people.
19. This offering of blood had been offered an untold number of times on earth in the tabernacle and temples, as a type of this final offering of Jesus' blood.
20. The mercy seat in the tabernacle represented the presence of God.
21. Here in Hebrews 9:24, it says Christ entered the holy places not made with hands, into heaven itself, to appear in the presence of God for us.
22. This is the offering that had been looked for since Lucifer sinned in Heaven, and Adam and Eve sinned in the Garden of Eden, and everyone else that has sinned.
23. Now, all sin has been paid for by Jesus Christ, and God is satisfied. (Isaiah 53:11)
24. If we believe the finished work of Christ, we can go to heaven. Believe, Believe, Believe.
25. Anything less, and we go to Hell.
